

PIAs Read it.

Dear Team,

As you are aware that assessments under DDU-GKY is on hold, due to closer of SDI portal. RSLDC team is continuously in coordination with MoRD and NSDC to bring Assessment & Certification on track. Based on the trail meetings it was decided by MORD that following 3 steps will be undertaken to complete the pending assessment:

1. MES Trade /Courses (Started before 15th August 2018):

a. Batches who have started training before 15th August 2018 are pending for NCVT assessment. It also includes the legacy batches of FY 2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18, 2018-19 (upto 15th August 2018).

b. Assessment of batches started before 15th August 2018 will be done through SDIS Portal (<https://www.sdis.gov.in/SDI/>) of DGT.

c. As the SDIS portal has been closed for PIAs after 15th August 2018, no candidate/batch can be registered through SDIS portal directly.

d. For assessment of such batches, registration of training centre, candidate and batch creation will be done by DGT team through back-end. For this MoRD will provide the candidate level data to DGT as per format enclosed at **annexure-I**.

d. You are requested to share the candidate data of candidates pending for NCVT assessment as per format enclosed at Annexure-I within one week. To expedite the process to clear the pending NCVT assessment your personal attention is requested.

g. Once the upload of data through back-end will be completed, MoRD will share the details with RSLDC (A&C). Further, RSLDC (A&C) will share this data with respective PIAs.

h. Pending certificate may be downloaded from SDIS portal (<https://www.sdis.gov.in/SDI/SearchCertificate.aspx>)

2. MES Trade /Courses (Started after 15th August 2018):

a. Assessment of batches started after 15th August 2018 will be done through Skill India portal (<https://skillindia.nsdcindia.org/>) of NSDC.

b. Training centres which were registered in SDIS portal have been migrated in Skill India portal and new login details have shared with training centres. If not received then, PIA will write to Skill India portal help-desk at Skillindia_helpdesk@nsdcindia.org and ac.rslhc@gmail.com along with SDIS portal ID.

c. PIAs can login through their training centres, after login they can register the candidates and create the batches for assessment.

d. In-case of any error/discrepancy during uploading the detail PIA may write to Skill India portal help-desk at Skillindia_helpdesk@nsdcindia.org. User Manual for Skill India portal is enclosed at **annexure-II**

e. Registration of new training centre at Skill India Portal will be routed through MoRD. MoRD will share the list of new training centres (where first time MES batch started) to be registered at Skill India portal NSDC. The details such training centres will be taken from MPR (<http://kaushalpragati.nic.in/>).

f. Scheme Coordinators are requested to monitor that all the details are updated in MPR on time.

3. SSC Trades/Courses:

3.1.1. Assessment of batches of current FY:

a. Assessment of SSC trades/courses will be done through SDMS portal (<https://www.nsdcindia.org/sdms-login>) of NSDC.

b. PIA wise login details for SDMS is attached as **annexure-III**. PIA may login through SDMS portal and upload their training centres and batches for assessment

c. Assessment of batches of current FY will be done through regular process.

d. SDMS user manual is enclosed at **annexure-IV**

3.1.2. Assessment of legacy batches:

e. To clear the pending assessment of earlier FY (2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18), **SDMS portal will allow the upload of batches by 3rd December 2018 to 23rd December 2018.**

f. Training Partners are requested to complete the uploading of legacy batches during 3rd December 2018 to 23rd December 2018.

Note :- This is last chance for all PIA's to clear there pendency **(2014-15, 2015-16, 2016-17, 2017-18 till 15th August, 2018 batches)** of Assessment & Certification under DDU-GKY. After that pendency data will not be considered at any level.
